Policies

Focus and Scope:

The journal publishes unpublished research papers of teachers, researchers, students and citizens in all areas of knowledge, from Education Basic, Technique and Technology, from Graduate to latu and strict specializations. The Authors must disclose if the text is unpublished, that is, if it was not published.

Process of peer review:

Articles will be reviewed by the Editorial Board of the journal and, if approved, will be forwarded to the evaluation of consultants. After appropriate possible corrections and suggestions, the article is accepted for publication if it has a Assent, and refused when two opinions are unfavorable. In the case a favorable and unfavorable opinion, the decision about publishing or not Article will be the Editorial Board. The evaluation is "blind", i.e. Without identification of authors and their respective dilutions, as well as the evaluators

External, observing secrecy in both cases.

Open access policy:

This journal provides immediate open access to its content, following the principle that making research freely available to the public knowledge provides largest worldwide democratization of knowledge.

Submissions:

Articles should be sent by electronic mail to the address jose.provetti @ ifpr.edu.br according to the criteria established in the directives for authors.

directives for authors:

- 1. Submission will be accepted for items sent by post to the address jose.provetti@ifpr.edu.br until the deadline of the call articles previously published through the website of IFPR Assis Chateaubriand and others ways of dissemination and popularization of philosophical, scientific knowledge and domestic and foreign technology.
 - 2. The journal publishes unpublished articles in all areas of knowledge.
- 3. Authors must disclose if the text is unpublished, that is, if it was not published.
- 4. Articles that are in accordance with the "directives for Authors" and conditions for the submission will be sent for analysis by the Editorial Board of the journal.
- 5. Articles accepted by the Editorial Board will be forwarded to the assessment of Ad hoc consultants magazine.





6. Aanalysis and assessment procedures of articles by referees are performed with the anonymity of the authors of the respective papers and opinion ("blind review"). Do not identify yourself in the text, nor in the file properties. Include biographical abstract to submit article in

body of the email.

- 7. Submitted papers must follow the following format and default:
- a) The articles should preferably be by a single author;
- b) will not be accepted article co-authored more than two authors;
- c) No submissions will be accepted in co-authorship involving mentees (as) and advisors (as);
- d) Articles may be submitted in Portuguese, Spanish, English, French or International Language Neutral Esperanto;
- e) Articles should contain: abstract (up to 500 words), key words (up to 5) (corresponding language in which the text is written) and references. All articles will be the abstract translated to the International Neutral Esperanto, which will be the responsibility of the Editor;
- e) The abstract, not exceeding 500 words, should contain summary information about the article. Up to five keywords should be appended to the end, that are not quoted the title;
- f) Articles should not exceed 15 pages with typed text and up to 20 including figures, tables and references. Should be written in 1.5 cm space, using Times New Roman font 12, A4 and margins should be: lower, upper, left and right 3cm. The file must be sent in "doc" or equivalent text editor format;
- g) photos, charts and graphics in general, should be sent in separately in JPG or GIF format, the smaller size (in KB) possible. The author (a) must indicate where to place;
 - h) Footnotes should only be of an explanatory;
- i) The bibliographic citations must meet the following examples, which are based on ABNT. Citation in the text: use the surname and year eg Caporalini (2005) (CAPORALINI, 2005); for two authors E.: Veiga and Santos (2008) or (Veiga and Santos, 2008); three or more authors use the first and after et al. Eg (GHEORGHIU et al, 2008.);
